Agricultural remedies (also known as pesticides) are regulated by the Fertilizers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act, 1947 (Act No. 36 of 1947) hereafter referred to as the Act and its associated regulations (general regulations: latest edition as per Government Gazette Regulation No. R. 953 of 22 September 2006 and specific regulations relating to Pest Control Operators as per Government Gazette Regulation No. R. 123 of 11 February 2011 [Read more:](#)
